Su Sayer CBE – Campaign to Protect Rural England

Su Sayer CBE was the co-founder and chief executive at United Response for 40 years until she stepped down in 2014. United Response supports people with learning disabilities, mental health or

physical support needs, with 3,500 staff across England and Wales. She is now a Vice President.

Awarded an OBE in 2000 for services to disabled people and a CBE in 2013, Su also received the Outstanding Achievement Award at the 2003 Charity Awards and the Lifetime Achievement Award at the 2004 Charity Times Awards.

She has served on the boards of several government bodies and a number of charities including Save the Children and Prostate Cancer UK. She is currently chair of CPRE, the Campaign to Protect Rural England, a trustee of the Silverline Helpline and the Urology Foundation. She is the Senior Independent Director at Hounslow and Richmond Community NHS Trust.



Dame Stephanie Shirley

Dame Stephanie Shirley is a highly successful entrepreneur turned ardent philanthropist.

She started what became Xansa in 1962. In 25 years as its Chief Executive she developed it into a leading business technology group,

pioneering new work practices and changing the position of professional women along the way.

Since retiring in 1993, she has served on corporate boards including the John Lewis Partnership plc (1999-2001), but her focus has been increasingly on philanthropy based on her strong belief in business people giving something back to society. Her main interests are autism and making better use of IT in the voluntary sector.

Her charitable Shirley Foundation is now one of the top 50 grant-giving foundations in the UK with well over £50m grants given. Current activity is focussed on Autistica in the UK and internationally, dedicated to fund research into the causes of autism and halve the global cost of the disorder by 2020.
